Facilities & Instruction

- One of the best overall range and practice facilities in southeastern Wisconsin is the setting of our program.
- Students will rotate thru 3 stations: Full Swing, Short Game, Putting, plus learn Rules/ Etiquette each week during our mid-class snack and rehydration break.
- Students are placed together in small groups of like age/ability and receive instruction in each golf area every week. This structured instruction will allow each student to maximize building their golf skills and provide more personalized instruction.

Golf on the Western Lakes Golf Course

All students in the Western Lakes Junior Golf Program may play golf at reduced 9-hole rates!

- Thursday evenings after 6:00 pm & Saturday and Sunday evenings after 3:00 pm
- Junior green fee is \$7; adult green fee is \$12
- Adult cart fee is \$8, junior golfers may ride along for free when cart is driven by an adult
- Junior golfers must be accompanied by an adult

Features Instruction, Games



Designed for children ages 5 & up, the beginner class starts out utilizing SNAG Golf for the first few weeks. Although at first glace this system may appear to be a toy, it is actually a state of the art teaching system that is proven to provide quicker results than regular golf clubs. After a few weeks, we then transition to regular junior sized golf clubs.
