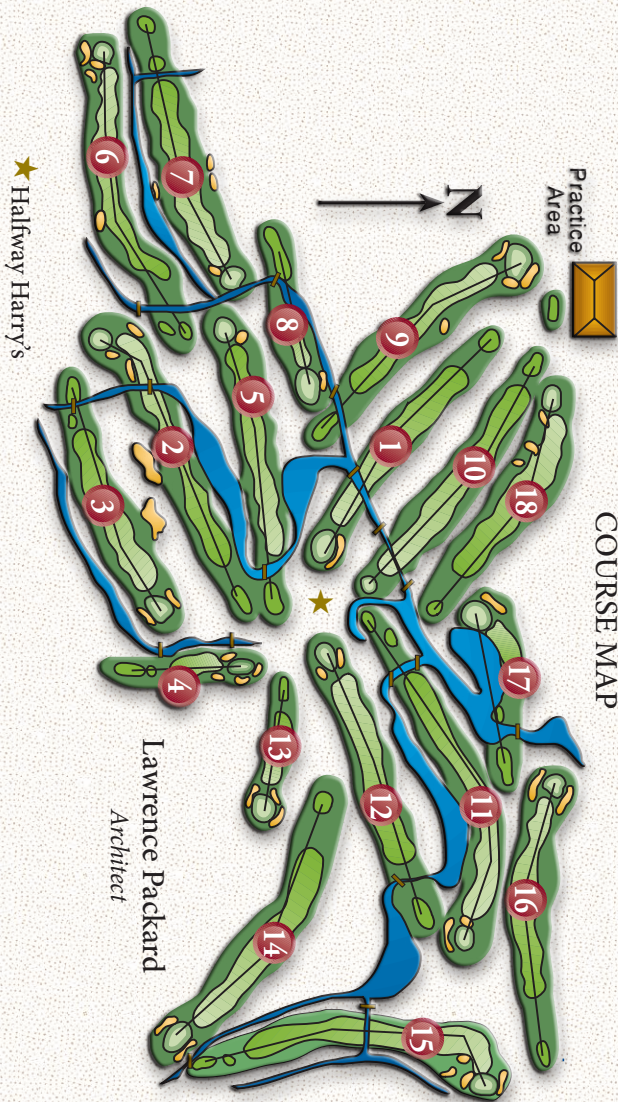
Pin Locations

USGA RULES GOVERN ALL PLAY

Local Rules:

- USGA Rules govern all play. Out-of-Bounds areas are defined by white stakes. All other areas are played as Hazards.
- Tree roots or Ground Under Repair: In the case where a tree root or Ground Under Repair interferes with an intended swing, the nearest point of relief may be taken, no nearer to the hole.
- A full list of the local rules sheet is available in the Golf Shop

Course Rules/Etiquette

- Pace of play: Our goal is to have a pace of 2 hours per 9 holes, or faster, with a maximum pace of 2 hours and 15 minutes. Please keep up with the group in front of you. Any group that falls out of position and behind pace may be asked to pick up and skip forward back into position.
- Please keep the carts on the paths around the tee boxes and greens.
- Please obey all cart signs and ropes.
- Please repair all ball marks, rake bunkers, and replace all divots.
- WI State Law prohibits the carry-on of alcoholic beverages. Carry-ons will be confiscated, and violators may be asked to leave the property without a refund.
- Golfers are responsible for any damage caused to the golf course or golf carts. They are also responsible for any damage/injuries caused by their golf ball.

Weather Policy:

- All players are to play at their own risk. WLGC is not responsible for issuing warnings about dangerous weather. Should you see/hear dangerous weather or feel uncomfortable with conditions, please seek shelter or come off the golf course.
